**What ATX Safer Streets did:**  
We gave all candidates running for Mayor and City Council a questionnaire, asking them for their opinions on transportation in Austin, with a focus on late-night transit.

**How ATX Safer Streets scored candidates:**  
Our questionnaire had 14 questions with a yes/no or positive/negative answer. We compared the candidate's answers to how we would have answered those same questions. We then added up the number of answers that agreed with ours, and divided that number by 14. The result is their ATX Safer Streets "score" which is a percentage of how we feel their answers are in line with ours.

**What should you do with this information:**  
These scores are not intended to be an endorsement for any one candidate, and are for informational purposes only. We encourage you to research each candidate and vote for the one you feel best represents you. We have each candidates' long form answer on our website [atxsafestreets.org](http://atxsafestreets.org), and we encourage you to go there to read their full responses.

**More information on scoring:**  
Candidates that did not respond to our questionnaire were not included. Candidates that did not answer a question, or answered "yes and no" or "I don't know" and didn't give a compelling argument for either side of the issue, did not have these answers included in their score.
